

Capítulo 3 PROJECT – ¿Qué hacen? y ¿Cuándo?

Explanation:

You will make a small book that includes eight pages or a poster with separate sections. Label the cover (book) or back side (poster) with the title: “¿Qué hacen? y ¿Cuándo?” and include Nombre, Fecha, Hora. Your project will include 7 pictures minimum. The first page (book) will be YOU. Your remaining pictures/photos may be of family, friends, celebrities, artists, cartoon characters, or any random people/animals in different seasons and types of weather.

Break-Down:

- Divide the book/poster into sections for the four seasons or different types of weather situations.
- Seven individuals and/or groups of people (**minimum**) must be represented – including yourself
- Include the name of each person in the visual.
- Include a minimum of 3 different activities done in that weather/season.
 - Conjugate verbs correctly! You may use querer once per visual.
 - Make sure the activity is logical for that section of the book or poster.
- Include how often at least one of the activities are done.
- **DO NOT USE ANY UNFAMILIAR VOCABULARY!**

Technical Requirements:

- Front cover of book or back of poster includes the following: the title, nombre, fecha, y hora.
- You must include a minimum of 7 different visuals in your booklet to receive an A.
- Do not write in pencil or the color yellow.
- All printing must be neat & easy to read.
- Use proper capitalization and punctuation!!
- Pictures/photos/cut-outs/clip art, etc. must be securely attached. Glue or tape all corners/edges of your visuals securely. (Rubber cement works well.)
- All pictures & descriptions must be **clearly identifiable** to count.
- Properly label all visuals with the activity descriptions. **Follow the models!**

Notes:

If doing a poster, include each description with its visual in the appropriate weather/seasonal section. If doing a book, include each description with its visual on separate pages within the appropriate section.

For visuals, you may choose to use actual photographs, cut-outs from magazines, newspapers, comics, clip-art, or your own neatly drawn & colored work, etc.

Models/Examples:

Follow these as you formulate your work, but come up with your own characters & descriptions!

The visuals can go in different order depending on how you've sectioned off your book/poster, but you must have all four types in the correct quantity.

One visual to describe self:

Yo soy Pablo Picasso.
En la primavera, paseo todos los días.

One visual to describe self + other(s):

Three visuals to describe a single individual:

Ésta es mi amiga Sandra.
Cuando llueve, ella escribe cartas en casa.

Éste es Brian Urlacher.
No canta mucho.
Es muy activo y hace ejercicio todos los días.
Juega al fútbol americano los domingos, los lunes y
los jueves en el invierno.

Two visuals to describe two or more individuals together:

Éstos son Juan y Roberto Kennedy.
Ellos siempre van al centro comercial en el otoño.
Compran muchos regalos para la Navidad.
Los fines de semana, cuando no van de compras,
trabajan porque necesitan dinero.

Éstas son Jennifer Lopez y Selena Gomez.
Cuando hace frío ellas hablan por teléfono o platican en línea.
A veces van al gimnasio y hacen ejercicio.
Siempre quieren bailar y bailan mucho en la casa de su amiga.
