**\*Note:** "Main Contribution" would be what the person(s) added to American culture (i.e. music style, writings, athletic achievements, etc.); "Cultural Significance in USA" is how that contribution has impacted the culture of the USA (i.e., what kind of difference it makes to people now; how many people now use the invention in their everyday lives; how many people watch or listen to the person's productions, etc.)
